

RECEPTION

We have enjoyed reading a variety of books on the theme of jungle animals this week. We have been finding out about animal camouflage and have been looking closely at the odour, pattern and shape of different animals. We have been using a range of vocabulary when engaged in problem solving activities this week. We have enjoyed using a variety of resources to help us answer the questions posed.

Next week we will continue to find out about a variety of animals, we are looking forward to our school trip on Wednesday!!



YEAR 1 NEWS....



The Year 1 staff are super proud of all the children for doing so well in their phonics screening. This week we have also been reading the story 'The Pig in the Pond' and then made our own story boards to help us retell the story. In Maths the children have been learning to multiply by 2, 5 and 10 using the 'x' sign to record number sentences. In Science we have looked at the materials used to build a house and designed our own. Next week we will use these to carry out an experiment.

YEAR 2 NEWS....



This week in Maths we have been looking at different turns and learning how to turn clockwise and anti-clockwise. It was a little tricky at first but we soon got the hang of it. Our topic is all about pirates this term. We learnt about the pirates' code of conduct and the punishments they faced if they broke their code. We compared this with modern day rules and consequences, writing our own Ladywood Code of Conduct. We concluded that modern day consequences are much more lenient than in the past! In guided reading we have been discussing the meaning of new words and using dictionaries to check these meanings. We have also been asking questions before reading and then using our book skills to find the answers in non-fiction books. We are still learning new sounds in phonics and new spelling rules in Get Spelling. Remember to practise your spellings at home! Finally we would like to wish all our fathers and grandfathers a very happy fathers' day.

In Maths next week we will be learning more about fractions of shapes and in topic we will be learning lots more about the life of pirates.

YEAR 3 NEWS....



This week in Year 3 we have been making lots of lovely things and preparing for our garden centre which is in a few weeks. The children have loved using glass paint to design tea light holders and vases. In Literacy we have really enjoyed writing non-chronological reports about console games that we have played at home. Well done Year 3 we have had a really good week!

YEAR 4 NEWS....



A busy week in class. In Topic we have been busy preparing for our garden centre. In Literacy we have been writing our own diary entries using paragraphs and fronted adverbials in Maths we have finally cracked translations we can now move shapes on a grid and use coordinates confidently.

Next week we will be looking at problems using written methods to solve them and we will be looking at subordinate clauses in Literacy.

YEAR 5 NEWS....



A really interesting and productive week in class. In Topic we have drawn an image of Stonehenge. In Maths we have looked at different types of angles and drawing and finding the missing angle. In Literacy we have looked at summarising paragraphs from larger extracts. We have also had fun practising for Athletics and the music festival which we are attending next week. please feel free to join us there. In Literacy we are going to be writing instructions for making and using bows and arrows. In Maths we will be recapping methods for division.
